

Admiral Residents Association: Committees and Resident-Initiated Groups

<u>Standing Committees</u> – Committees essential to conducting the business of the Resident Association. A member of the Steering Committee will be an ex officio member of these committees:

Budget/Financial Review

Formulates the Residents Association Budget and reviews Committee/Interest Group requests for funds

Fundraising

Oversees all fundraising activities of the Residents Association

Communications

Devises and improves methods of communications with residents, both written and electronic. See also newsletter

Program/Events

Plans and executes programs of interest to the entire community such as lectures, music, or other events

Audit

Appointed annually by the Steering Committee to audit the books of the Residents Association

Nominating

Appointed annually by the Steering Committee to nominate Resident Association Council candidates for the following year

Bylaws

Tasked with writing the initial Residents Association Bylaws, thereafter reviews Bylaws annually or when circumstances require

<u>Liaison Committees</u> – These committees communicate with management in an advisory capacity. Membership is open to all with one Steering Committee/Council member as an ex officio member:

Admiral Finances

Reviews The Admiral at the Lake's annual budget from the Residents point of view **Culinary Services**

Advises Culinary Services on menus, service, and special events

Facilities

Advises Facilities Management on issues involving the physical plant and resident well-being and safety

Health and Wellness

Advises and communicates with health and wellness staff including the Fitness Center. See also Fitness.

Human Resources

Marketing

Advises Marketing in activities including marketing luncheons, tours and other events

Safety and Security

Transportation

<u>Community Service Committees</u> – Implements the charitable purpose of The Admiral Residents Association and upholds the Kendal Value: *to take responsibility in the larger community*, maintaining extensive and mutually supportive relationships and sharing our resources and experience.

Residents do not need to be a Committee Member to engage in volunteer activities sponsored by the Residents Association. However, people interested in investigating, organizing and leading these activities are needed on the Committees.

Oversees activities with Goudy School reading buddies

Identifies and publicizes inside and outside volunteer opportunities

Welcomes new residents into the community with information and hospitality

<u>Resident-Initiated Groups (RIG)</u> – Groups initiated by residents, which are typically informal, small groups or residents having specialized interests (e.g., Gardeners) or groups who give specialized assistance to residents (e.g., Library):

Implements policies regarding display of resident-owned art, decides on gallery exhibits, investigates possible programs on art-related topics

Brown Bag Book Group

Cards and Games/Bridge/Chess/MahJongg

Facilitates programs involving card and other games

Catholic Mass

Computer Support

Assists residents in use of computers

Creative Arts

Oversees use of and plans programs for the Creative Arts Studio in Independent Living **Ecumenical Prayer Service**

Fireside Chat

Monthly meeting between residents and CEO to discuss resident interests and concerns

Fitness

Advises Fitness Center on programs and programs of interest to Residents. This Committee is interested in having members who participate in Fitness Center activities

Flower Arranging

Friends Group

Garden Group

Provides inside and outside gardening opportunities, field trips, and related programs

Knitting

Less of Me (Weight/Fitness)

Library

Selects books for the library, makes decisions on donations, manages upkeep of library

Lifelong Learning

Investigates and implements programs for lifelong learning both within and without the Admiral. This Committee works directly with the CEO

Low Vision Support Group

Memory Caregivers Support Group

Men's Group

Movies

Selects movies to be shown in the Theatre, provides film-related programs

Anchor Newsletter

Publishes newsletter by and for Residents

Pets

Takes care of pets whose owners are away and discusses mutual concerns of Admiral pet owners

Plans and executes trips and other outings for shopping, education, and entertainment
